A DIY Snow Globe

What you need:

- A clean, glass jar with watertight lid
- Decorations - whatever you like, we chose a craft tree and reindeer figure
- Glitter or sequins
- String or ribbon to decorate the outside of the jar (optional)
- Hot Glue Gun
- Clear craft glue or Glycerin (available from most chemists)

Step 1:

As we're using a craft tree we've pre-soaked it in warm water to stop any of the dye changing the colour of the water of our snow globe. You won't have to do this if you are only using plastic items.

Step 2:

Take the lid and arrange your decorations on it, when you are happy with the layout, get an adult to use the glue gun to stick them down. (Make sure you leave space around the edge of the lid so it will still screw onto the jar.)

Step 3:

Pour water into the jar stopping about 2 fingers from the top. Add the glitter or sequins into the water (as much as you like) then add approx. 3 tablespoons of glycerin or clear glue into the jar (we are using a medium jar but you may need more or less depending on the size of your jar).

Step 4:

Carefully fasten your lid onto the jar. To make it extra secure you can get an adult to glue it closed so no water can escape.

Step 5:

Decorate the outside of your jar with your ribbon or string (optional).

Then enjoy shaking your snow globe and watching the glitter swirl around like snow.
